1936. SC O 192, 10c Geochelone elephantopus. This is Scott Ecuador #342 o/p in black w/ a vertical: "OFFICIAL".

1957. SC LC 3, 4.20s Geochelone elephantopus. Listed under "Galapagos Islands" at the end of "Ecuador" in the Scott Catalog.

1961. SC C 391, 4.20s Geochelone elephantopus. This is Scott Ecuador LC3 o/p in red: "Estacion de Biologia Maritima de Galapagos" and "UNESCO 1961".

1973. SC 874, 70c Geochelone elephantopus.

1986. SC 1119, 50s Geochelone elephantopus. Turtle is incorrectly identified by Scott as a sea turtle.

1994. SC 1344, 600s Geochelone elephantopus . Tiny tortoise in upper right quadrant of small logo for "Ecuador Antarctica Program". Tortoise is directly opposite penguin in logo. Inscribed "Presence of Ecuador in Antarctic". Magnification needed to see tortoise distinctly.

1994. SC 1345, 900s Geochelone elephantopus. Tiny tortoise in upper right quadrant of small logo for "Ecuador Antarctica Program". Tortoise is directly opposite penguin in logo. Inscribed "Presence of Ecuador in Antarctic". Magnification needed to see tortoise distinctly.

1999. SC 1492f , 15000s G. elephantopus porteri. Single stamp w/ turtle from Scott Ecuador #1492. Head-on photo of adult. Honors Charles Darwin Foundation.

1999. SC 1491 j, 7000s G. elephantopus abingdoni. Single stamp w/ tortoise from Scott Ecuador #1491. Head-on photo of adult w/ head lowered. Honors Charles Darwin Foundation.

2003. SC 1671 b, \$1.05 Chelonia mydas agassizi. Adult swimming up and right. Inscribed "Reserva Marina de Galapagos". Single stamp w/ turtle from Scott Ecuador #1671.

2004. SC 1719, \$1.05 Small Stylized Turtle. Many birds, animals, trees, etc. in circular design in middle of stamp. Small turtle at bottom of circle. Stamp inscribed "Proteccion del Medio Ambiente" and "America '04".

2005. SC 1750d, 0.4 Chelonia mydas. Photo of SCUBA diver and turtle underwater. Inscribed "Galapagos", "Tortuga Marina" and "Los Cuarto Mundos". Individual stamp from Scott Ecuador #1750. Scott lists date as 26 Sept 05 but an FDC exists dated 26 Dec 05.

2005. SC 1724, \$2.00 Stylized Tortoise. S/S w/ Swallow-tailed gulls as main design feature. One gull w/ wings outstretched. Small stylized tortoise and hammerhead shark in logo in upper left corner. Wording under logo as follows: "Parque Nacional Galapagos Ecuador".

2005. SC 1722, \$2.15 Stylized Tortoise. Sula granti (Nacza Booby) is main design feature. Small stylized tortoise and hammerhead shark on logo in upper

right corner. Wording under logo as follows: "Parque Nacional Galapagos Ecuador".

2005. SC 1723, \$3.00 Stylized Tortoise. Frigate bird is main design feature. Small stylized tortoise and hammerhead shark on logo in upper right corner. Wording under logo as follows: "Parque Nacional Galapagos Ecuador".

2005. SC 1721, 0.90c Stylized Tortoise. Marine Iguana is main design feature. Small stylized tortoise and hammerhead shark on logo in upper left corner. Wording under logo as follows: "Parque Nacional Galapagos Ecuador".

2005. SC 1720, 0.40c Chelonoids abingdonii. Photo of tortoise as main design feature plus small stylized tortoise and hammerhead shark in logo in lower right corner. Wording under logo as follows: "Parque Nacional Galapagos Ecuador".

2005. SC 1750, 40c Chelonia mydas. Block of four containing one Scott Ecuador #1750d which depicts the turtle. Scott lists date as 26 Sept 05 but an FDC exists dated 26 Dec 05.

2006. SC 1842a 30c Geochelone elephantopus. Adult facing left w/ head turned to face viewer. Inscribed "Islas Galapagos", "Galapago" and "IMP.IGM -2006". Scott incorrectly identifies the turtle as a sea turtle.

2007. \$5 Chelonia mydas. Two turtles swimming to right underwater; one in foreground and one in background. From set of ten marine creatures.

2007. SC 1913, 0.40c Chelonia mydas. Turtle swimming to right underwater is main design element. Inscribed "Galapagos" in large letters in lower right corner.

2008. SC 1924, 1.20usd Geochelone elephantopus. Tortoise in lower left corner of stamp. Three windmill type electric generators in background. Small map of Galapagos Islands in upper right corner. Inscribed "Galapagos" in large letters in lower right corner. Inscribed "Proyecto Ealico San Cristobal" in small letters in bottom selvedge.

2008. SC 1934, 32c Cartoon-Like Turtle. Fiftieth Anniversary of the Higher Polytechnic Institute of the Coast. School's emblem is circular, w/ a turtle in the center and it appears twice on the stamp. Stamp inscribed "50 Anos Escuela Superior Politecnica del Litoral".

2009. SC 1981, 50 Geochelone elephantopus, Portrait of Charles Darwin in upper half of stamp. Four rectangular pictures across lower half of stamp, one of which depicts a tortoise (Lonesome George). Additional tortoise in the middle of the numeral "0" in the number "50".

2009, SC 1974, 0.25c Geochelone elephantopus Individual stamp w/ tortoise from se-tenant pair issued this date. Issued for 100 years of diplomatic relations between Ecuador and China.

2009, SC 1982, 2.00usd Geochelone elephantopus. Individual round stamp from s/s issued this date. Has a very small portrait of Charles Darwin near bottom of stamp.
